Just like a Mamma's Recipe

"Crèma Italiano" (Italian custard)

Ingredients:

2 egg yolks
1 cup white sugar
3-4 heaped tablespoons cornflour
600ml Full Cream Milk (don't use trim milk)
1 tsp cinnamon (to sprinkle on top while cooling)

Method:

In a stainless steel pot, beat egg yolks and sugar together. Add cornflour and mix. Pour in milk and simmer over stove top till it becomes thick and custardy texture and remove from stove top – you will find it may be lumpy. Hand beat with a wooden spoon until smooth. Pour into a round plate. Sprinkle with cinnamon and let cool.

When the crèma cools down, it gets very thick, so to soften it up, put into a bowl, add 3 tbsp vermouth and 1 tbsp melted butter, and beat quickly together until you get a runnier texture.

You can use this crèma to make custard squares, trifles, or anything requiring crèma.





To ensure a place in your preferred class it is advisable that enrolments be made by post or through the Internet prior to **Friday 30 January 2015**. It is not necessary for Club Garibaldi members to join the Circolo and only the course fees need to be paid - \$215.00 for 30 fifty-five minute lessons.
