## THE ANZAC SPIRIT - 2016

On ANZAC Day, Monday, 25 April, club member and former president Ginette Toscano Page, represented Club Garibaldi at a commemoration Service that was held at the Takapuwahia Marae, Porirua. This is the 5<sup>th</sup> time Ginette has been invited and attended ANZAC services at this marae.

The Takapuwahia Marae has a close bond with Italy as many of their members were soldiers who fought at Cassino during WW2...dozens did not return back home to NZ and today, they lie in Italian soil.

Representatives from various countries including myself and the Commissioner of Police, laid wreaths and flowers on the Memorial Stone, which sits just below the NZ flag pole. Then members of the marae were invited to place photos of their dead soldier family members on the stone.

Members of all armed services, dressed in formal uniform also attended. Dedications were made, followed by two guest speakers who spoke of family stories which had been handed down from returning soldiers.

After prayers and singing, a One Minute Silence was observed followed by a young bugler playing "The Last Post'. It was very moving.

After the service, the official guests were escorted to the dining room for luncheon by three young women dressed in authentic 1940's attire to suit the occasion; one of whom was in full army uniform.

While the service was formal it was filled with warmth and love, and as always, I felt very comfortable, welcome and honoured to be there.
