Radio Cartolina Programme for August/September





Family Business: An Italian-New Zealand Story by Vincent Moleta



An Italian-New Zealand Story is the work of Wellington-born, Australianbased medieval scholar and publisher Vincent Moleta who has written a moving account of his family's determined efforts to establish a new life in a new country.

Dr Moleta's maternal grandparents, Bartolo and Giuseppina Barnao, were among the small number of non-British Europeans who immigrated to New Zealand, in their case from the Aeolian island of Stromboli, off the north coast of Sicily, at the turn of the 20th century. Through their story, and that of their descendants, Dr Moleta reveals how the small, tightly-knit Italian community became successfully integrated into New Zealand life while upholding their cultural traditions and practices.
